



Dr. Manu Vatish

Professor Manu Vatish is an academic obstetrician at the University of Oxford and the John Radcliffe hospital in Oxford.

He is clinically active and has clinical interests in high-risk obstetrics.

He runs two research groups – one with a basic science interest in placental function with special reference to circulating extracellular vesicles and their role in preeclampsia and the second with clinical interests in the roles of angiogenic biomarkers for the diagnosis and prediction of preeclampsia.

Additionally he is RCOG college tutor for Oxford and academic training programme director for the Oxford University Clinical Academic Graduate School.

He is clinical director of the NIHR Clinical Research Network for Reproductive Health and Childbirth for the Thames Valley and sits on the National Reproductive Health and Childbirth Committee.
